Chicken & Broccoli Alfredo

Prep/Cook Time: 20 minutes

½ package *uncooked* linguine (8 ounces)
1 cup fresh or frozen broccoli flowerets

2 tablespoons butter or margarine 1 pound skinless, boneless chicken breasts,

1 can (103/4 ounces) CAMPBELL'S® Cream of Mushroom Soup or 98% Fat Free Cream of Mushroom Soup

½ cup milk ½ cup grated Parmesan cheese

1/4 teaspoon freshly ground pepper

 Prepare linguine according to package directions. Add broccoli for last 4 minutes of cooking time.

2. In medium skillet over medium-high heat, heat butter. Add chicken and cook until browned, stirring

3. Add soup, milk, cheese, pepper and linguine mixture and cook through, stirring occasionally. Serve with additional Parmesan cheese.




