How The Clubhouse Benefits MembersBy Jessica K.

The Clubhouse's main objective is to help members get well. It is a program of support for people recovering from mental illness. It aims to help people excel in all parts of their lives, and this is how Clubhouse is considered unique.

The Clubhouse members work side by side with each other and staff to contribute in meaningful ways. It fights stigma because people who are of importance are more than just patients with a disability. It allows people to focus on their success more than their troubles. Clubhouse aims to do this with the Work Ordered Day, Social Outings, and Employment.

The Work Ordered Day consists of work just like any other job, but with emphasis on member's abilities rather than their limitations. The Clubhouse staff and members are very committed to establishing good relationships with one another.

Clubhouse has Transitional, Supported and Independent Employment. Transitional Employment is a part time job that lasts 6-9 months and is highly structured for members returning to work. Supported Employment is an individual job with support from the clubhouse. People who want to find jobs on their own can consider Independent Employment.

Social Outings are another outlet to getting to know one another. It helps having a bond with one another, especially at a time when it is after the important work of the day is complete.

These are quotes from some Northern Lights Clubhouse Members when they answered the question, "How Clubhouse helps me?"

Alicia: It helps me stay active. The Clubhouse keeps my interest in other things than watching TV all day. It is good for me to have the Work Ordered Day. It gives me a taste of working in the real world. I've come to start developing relationships.

Doug: Clubhouse gives me a place to go. It lets me associate with others similar to me. It gets me out of the house.

Casey: Clubhouse gives me structure to my day. It keeps me socialized. It gives me meaningful work to do. It helps me in my ongoing recovery. It teaches me new skills.

Mike: Clubhouse helps me to get out of my apartment. I like to visit with people. Lunch is great too.

Bushy: Northern Lights Clubhouse is allowing me to live life again. The services provided will help me grow as a person and, hopefully, see joy and a sense of community. The members and staff are what makes Clubhouse the best asset that a person with mental illness can have.

Jessica: The Clubhouse has helped me in many ways. It helps me to be more confident and believe in myself. It also allows me to make new friends and become more social.

A.E. Seaman Mineral Museum Outing by Alicia



Taffy Apple Cupcakes

What fun...gooey caramel-topped cupcakes on a stick!

18-1/4 oz. pkg. carrot cake mix1 c. Granny Smith apples, cored, peeled and finely chopped1/2 t. cinnamon20 caramels, unwrapped

1/4 c. milk1 c. pecans or walnuts, finely chopped12 wooden craft sticks

Prepare cake mix according to package instructions; stir in apples and cinnamon. Fill paper-lined jumbo muffin cups 2/3 full. Bake at 350 degrees for 20 to 25 minutes, until a toothpick inserted near center tests clean. Combine caramels and milk in a small saucepan over low heat; stir until melted and smooth. Spread caramel over cooled cupcakes; sprinkle nuts over top. Insert a craft stick into center of each cupcake. Makes one dozen.


