Clinical

Mental Health Treatment

Assessment and treatment in an outpatient setting. Includes individual group and/or family therapy. Peer support for youth, adults and parents.

Co-Occurring Disorders Treatment

Serves people in recover by offering mental health and substance abuse treatment together.

Psychiatric Services

Assessment and Medication management in an Outpatient setting.

Case Management/Supports Coordination

Coordination and support to meet basic needs, including employment and housing support, with regular oversight

Emergency Services

Crisis intervention, assessment, safety planning and pre-screening for inpatient hospitalization.
Available 24/7

Nursing Services

Residential and Outpatient clinical nursing.



Specialized Programs

Assertive Community Treatment (ACT)

Team approach for individuals with severe and persistent mental illness living in the community.

Home-Based Services

Intensive therapy and case management provided in the home and/or community for prenatal to young adult and family.

Intensive Care Coordination with Wraparound

Team approach using a family driven planning process for youth and families with complex needs.

Autism Benefit

Assessment and treatment for youth with an autism diagnosis. Provided in home, clinic and community.

Access

Screening to determine eligibility for an intake assessment.

BRAVO

Community support for people with diagnosis of intellectual/developmental disabilities.

Community Support

Community support for people with diagnosis of serious mental illness.

Clubhouse (Psychosocial Rehabilitation)

Community-based program for adults with serious mental illness focusing on a work-ordered day.

Nursing Home Services (OBRA/PASARR)

Team approach assessments and recommendations for individuals residing in long-term facilities.

Medication Deliveries

Available up to 2x per day based on treatment recommendations.

Michigan licensed residential setting. Homes located in local neighborhoods.

Fit Together

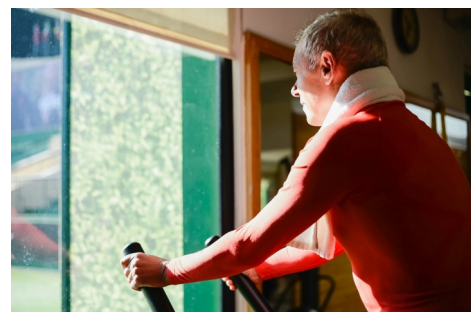
Designed to encourage consumers to take an active role in improving their physical health and wellbeing.

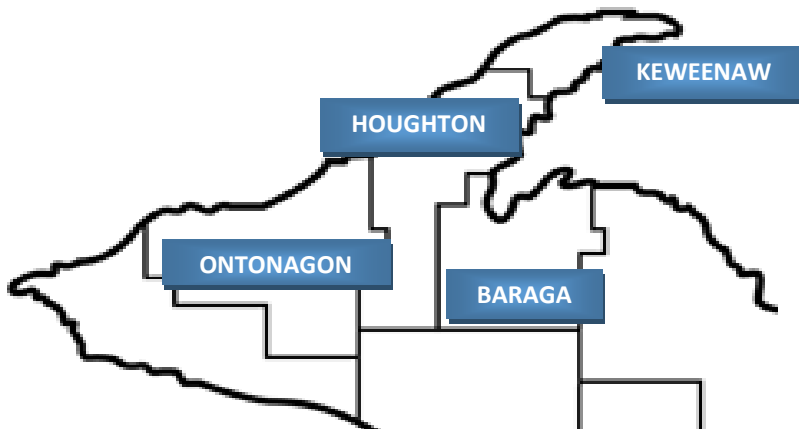
